The EDUCON conference offers academic, research, government, and industry professionals a platform to facilitate the advancement of engineering education, as a renowned international forum for collaboration, networking, learning, and sharing the latest advancements in education. Accepted and presented papers will be submitted to the IEEE Xplore® Digital Library for publication and will appear in the Conference Proceedings Citation Index (CPCI)—an integrated index within Web of Science, SCOPUS.

Main Theme: Engineering Digital Education Ecosystems: Harnessing AI, XR, Cybersecurity, and Emerging Technologies for the Future of Education

Include subthemes dedicated to education technologies, microcredentials, the use of AI, the role of digital education into the development of innovative engineering education, the role European Universities Alliances play in education.

The theme positions EDUCON 2027 as a leading forum addressing critical global issues through innovative educational approaches, digital transformation, digital ecosystems, technological advancement, and sustainable development. Digital transformation is reshaping education into an increasingly interconnected ecosystem where artificial intelligence, cybersecurity, immersive technologies, mixed reality, blockchain, data-driven learning, and intelligent digital platforms are becoming integral to teaching, learning, assessment, and institutional development.
