 - Tuesday, April 7, 2026 8:00 to 12:00

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- » Tutorial proposals must be prepared using the official tutorial template
- » The submission deadline is February 2, 2026
- » All tutorial proposals will be reviewed and approved by MeMeA2026 Technical Program Committee
- » Each tutorial may include up to two active instructors.
